CLUBHOUSE AND GROUNDS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.) Membership cards, gate card and stickers shall not be lent to non-members.
- 2.) All vehicles must display a current year sticker. Visitors shall park in designated areas only.
- 3.) Anyone on grounds or in clubhouse must show identification when requested.
- 4.) Except by special written permission by the Clubhouse & Grounds Chair, or a member of the Board of Trustees, the privileges of the clubhouse and grounds shall be limited to members, their immediate household and up to six (6) guests at any one time.

Members will be held responsible for their own property and that of their guests. Members will be held responsible for the conduct and indebtedness of their children, guests and pets.

Members shall pay for damages, destruction or wear due to misuse of furnishings or property inflicted by themselves, their guests and or their pets.
- 5.) Pets on the grounds must be leashed. No pets shall be allowed in the clubhouse. The club cannot assume responsibility for injury or death of a pet. Members are required to pick up after their pets (pooper-scooper) immediately.
- 6.) Parking is not permitted in the primary turn-a round areas, in posted NO PARKING areas or in posted RESERVE PARKING slots at the docks.
- 7.) No person shall remove from the clubhouse or grounds, any property belonging to the club or any member of the club, except as authorized by the Clubhouse and Grounds Chair or a Board member. (This includes firewood.)
- 8.) Articles, notices, etc. shall be posted and or displayed only on designated boards. Members of the Clubhouse and Grounds committee or the Board will remove any objectionable material (as determined by them). Please date when posting.
- 9.) All suggested alterations to the clubhouse and or grounds must be approved by the Board of Trustees and can only be initiated when written authorization is received. This includes the hanging of items on the wall.
- 10.) All littering is prohibited. Please place all garbage, cans, bottles, etc. in the designated containers.
- 11.) Alcohol is permitted on the club grounds. No alcoholic beverage of any kind shall be served or consumed by any person under the legal age of 21.
- 12.) No alcoholic beverage of any type will be provided by the club or any club member for sale or gratuity at any time. Chair person's and or committee members are not authorized to represent the dispensing of such beverages to members of their committee as a club approved practice.
- 13.) No smoking inside the clubhouse at any time.

- 14.)Maximum vehicle speed on the grounds is 5 MPH.
- 15.)There shall be no open fires on the grounds except for designated fire pit area located outside of the clubhouse.
Members may cook on portable grills at a member's dock or use the grill provided at the clubhouse.
- 16.)Fires in the clubhouse fireplace must be attended. Fires are to be extinguished by "Last Person".
- 17.)There shall be no discharge of firearms, flares or fireworks on the grounds except by permission of a member of the board.
- 18.)Fish cleaning shall be done in designated area only. Any fish remains improperly disposed of will result in the withdrawal of this convenience and suspension of member(s) involved.
- 19.)Any donation of furnishings, materials, etc. for the clubhouse and or grounds must be approved by a member of the Clubhouse and Grounds Committee prior to being brought to the grounds.
- 20.)Regular members, except members of the Board of Trustees and Committee Chairs, shall be required to perform eight hours of work per year. NEW MEMBERS MUST work four hours the first year at the clubhouse, grounds, ramp and or docks unless otherwise assigned. These mandatory work hours must be worked and cannot be purchased in lieu of work.
- 21.)Mandatory work hours not worked will be assessed at a rate of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per hour. This assessment must be paid before renewal of membership can be approved.
- 22.)Abusive, obscene, or obnoxious language and or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Any member may report such violations, IN WRITING, to the board of trustees.
- 23.)The last person leaving the clubhouse shall be responsible for turning off lights, checking fire, setting thermostats, and securing the clubhouse. All members are responsible for general observations of the grounds and good housekeeping principles.
- 24.)If you hold a Charter boat license your membership fee will be \$400.00, \$200.00 of this is your regular membership fee and the other \$200.00 is a Charter boat license fee. If you use the fish cleaning station more than 2 times a week/50 times per season, (May-Nov.) you will be charged \$1.00 per fish cleaned. This fee will be on the honor system and is to be paid at the end of the season. (Nov.)
