DOCKS, RAMPS & STORAGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) No fueling boats at docks or club grounds.
- 2) Members shall be personally responsible for the conduct and safety of their guests.
- 3) Maximum speed of any vessel within the basin shall be such that the vessel produces NO WAKE.
- 4) There is no swimming allowed in the club marina basin.
- 5) Deposit for dock to be in by close of FHRRA general membership meeting held in Oct. Deposits are non-refundable after January 31st. Payment in full to be in by close of FHRRA general membership meeting held in April. Depending on weather, docks are in on May 1st and removed by November 1st. Electrical and water should be turned on by these dates.
- 6) It is the docker's responsibility to notify the Dockmaster of any changes. Dockmaster will maintain registration forms on a 5x7 card on all people docking.
- 7) The club shall not be responsible for loss or damage of property or any loss sustained on the premises by members or guests.
- 8) Each member shall, upon unloading their equipment, park their vehicle in the designated parking area.
- 9) All boats coming off the river and are in the slip at the club have the right-of-way to ramps. If only one ramp is available and there is a boat approaching the ramp, if you are not in the process of backing up to the water, you will need to wait until that boat coming in is loaded.
- 10) No unattended children under the age of 10 years old are permitted on the dock. All children under 10 years old, must wear life jackets (or approved floatation devices) in or near the dock or ramp area. Children are not permitted to play on any boats or docks or fish from either, other than their own without permission of the owner.
- 11) Owners are responsible for their pets. They are to stay on a leash and owners are responsible for cleaning up after them.
- 12) Construction at the docks is to be approved by the Board of Trustees.
- 13) All dockers and trailer storage owners are responsible for keeping their area clean from rubbish and trash and for keeping the surrounding grass mowed. The maintenance of the 20 T-Docks area are from the center of the power box to the middle of the sidewalk of your dock as well as the grass on the hill. The 8 parallel docks are 35 feet per dock.
- 14) Stickers provided by the club, must be displayed on boat, car and or truck as well as tag stored on trailer.
- 15) Any problem that cannot be resolved by the Dockmaster will go to the Board and will be referred to Operating Procedure #7.
- 16) Guests will park in designated area.
- 17) Clean fish at designated area only.
- 18) All boaters must turn in proof of insurance, at least liability to secretary when boat sticker is issued.
